Dear Mr. James:

At the public hearing on August 16, 1971 before the County Planning Commission in consideration of our request for modifications to the Minnehaha County Zoning Regulations, one of the expressed concerns seemed to be that all farm equipment would have to be fitted with radio frequency interference suppressants.

Critical to the EROS Data Center when it operates with direct read-outs from an orbiting satellite is an electrically quiet location. The site was tested before selection and found acceptable. However, should any difficulties or trouble spots with farm equipment develop in the future, it will be taken care of at Government expense. Should any equipment need suppressors the Government will supply, install, and maintain them at no expense to the farmer.

Our concern is that the site be adequately protected so that it will continue to be useable for a Data Center such as we plan to build and operate. The Board of Commissioner's favorable consideration of our requested zoning modifications is appreciated.
