### Water Supply for EROS Project

Please accept this letter as confirmation of the willingness of the City of Sioux Falls to serve as the source of supply, through the facilities of its Water Department, for the potable water requirements of the EROS Project presently being planned.

According to the current expansion program of the Water Department, the water distribution system is being extended north to the vicinity of Benson Road and Fourth Avenue. It is estimated that water will be available at this point before construction of the EROS facility is completed.

By agreement, city water could be delivered into an underground reservoir, or through other suitable facilities, for pickup and transmission through the EROS system to its terminal.

We trust this statement of willingness will assist in expediting the completion and acceptance of your plans for this project.
