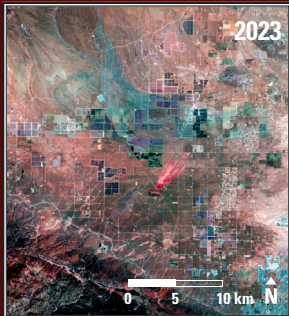
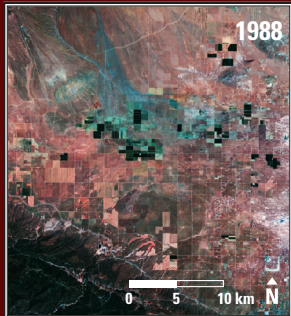


Antelope Valley, California, USA
