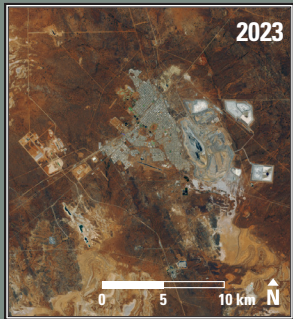
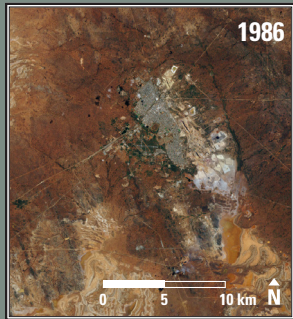


Kalgoorlie, Western Australia
